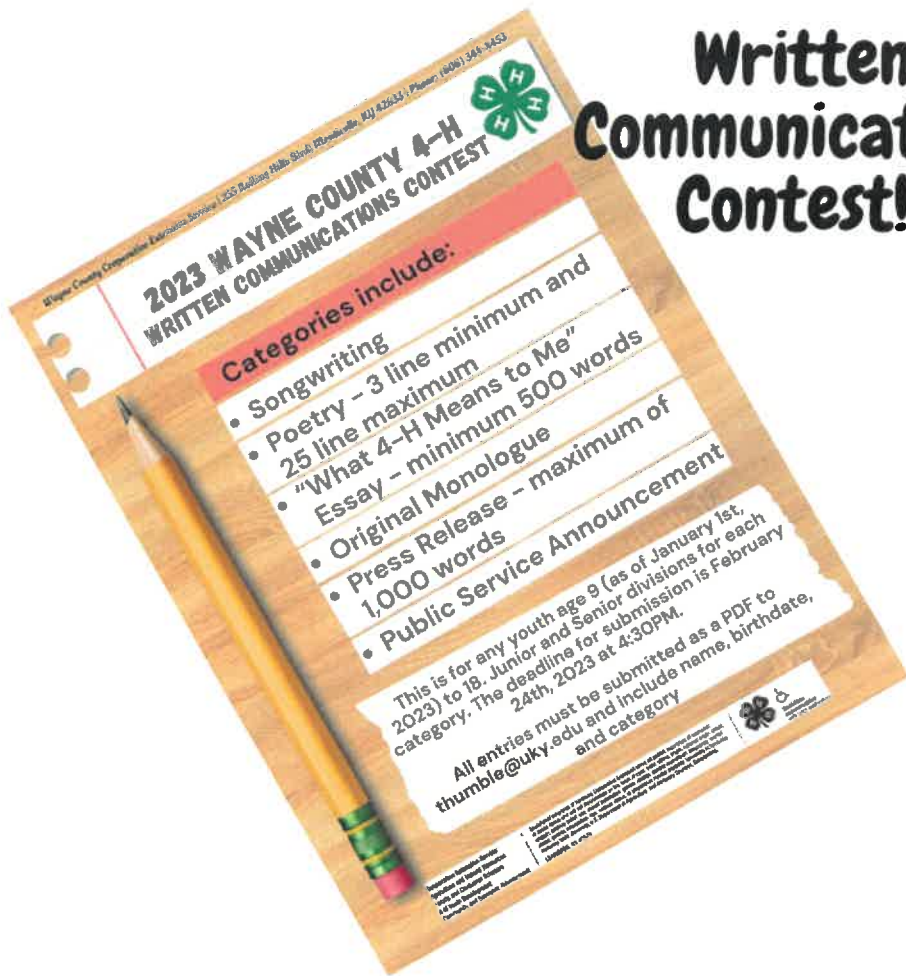

Snow Cream

Ingredients:

- *1 cup milk
- *1/2 cup sugar
- *1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- *pinch of salt
- *8-10 cups fresh clean snow
- *sprinkles, optional

Instructions:

1. In a medium-size bowl, whisk to combine milk, sugar, vanilla, and salt.
2. Pour mixture over 8 cups of snow and stir to combine. If needed, stir in up to two cups more snow to reach the desired consistency.
3. Scoop into bowls, add sprinkles (optional), and enjoy!



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
